



Das *simple present* kommt häufig mit folgenden Signalwörtern vor:
often – oft, *sometimes* – manchmal, *always* – immer, *never* – nie,
usually – gewöhnlich, *Mondays/Tuesdays ...* – montags/dienstags ...

Present progressive bei gerade ablaufender Handlung:

→ *At the moment, Bob is playing tennis.*

Simple present bei gewohnheitsmäßiger Handlung:

→ *Peter never plays football.*
